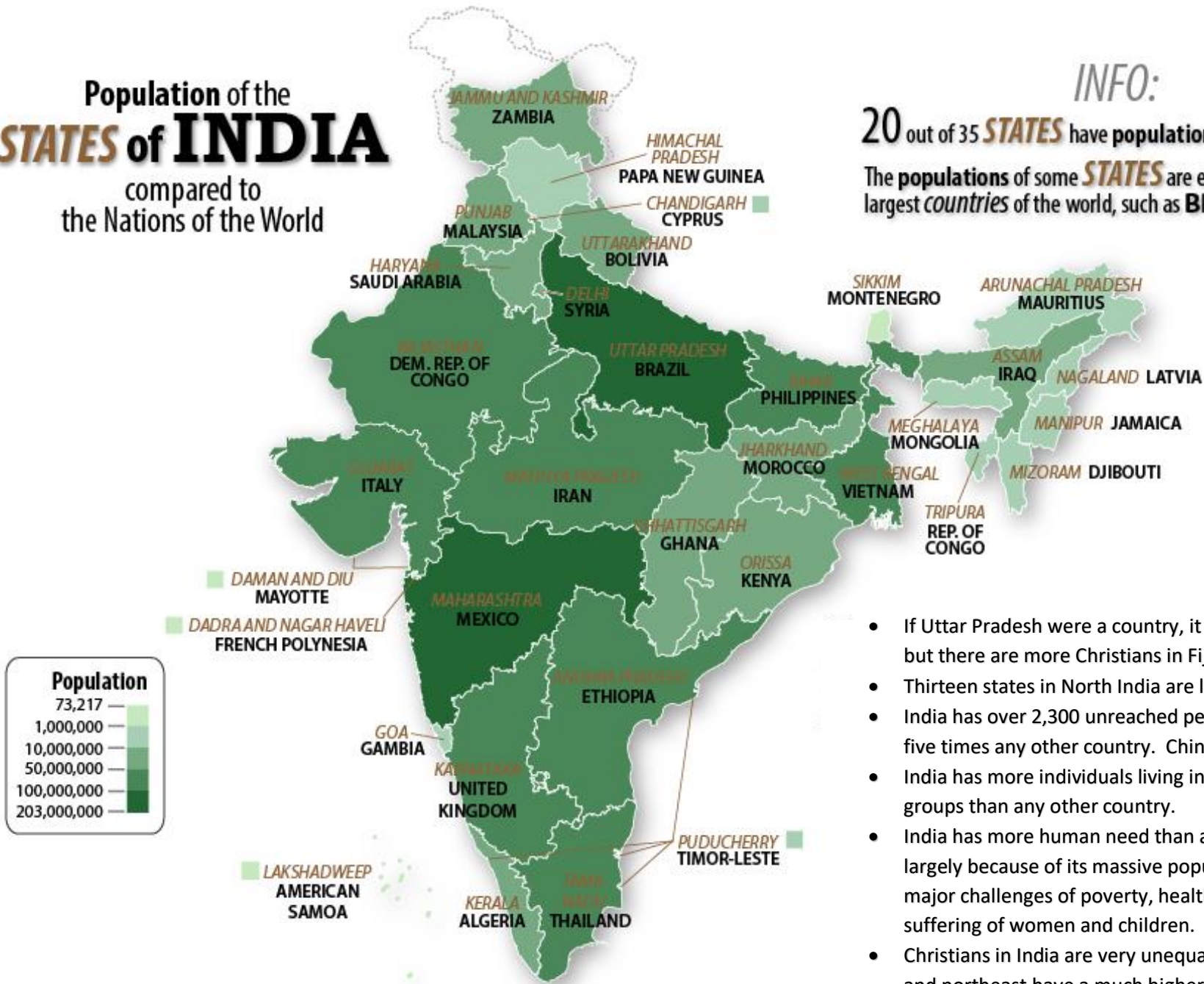


# Population of the STATES of INDIA compared to the Nations of the World

## INFO:

20 out of 35 STATES have populations over 10 million

The populations of some STATES are equivalent to some of the largest countries of the world, such as BRAZIL and MEXICO.



- If Uttar Pradesh were a country, it would be the 5th largest, but there are more Christians in Fiji than in Uttar Pradesh.
- Thirteen states in North India are less than 1% Christian.
- India has over 2,300 unreached people groups; more than five times any other country. China is 2nd with about 450.
- India has more individuals living in unreached people groups than any other country.
- India has more human need than any other country – largely because of its massive population, but also due to major challenges of poverty, health concerns and the suffering of women and children.
- Christians in India are very unequally spread – the south and northeast have a much higher proportion of Christians than the more populated north and west.
- Every day, the population of India increases by 43,000.
