Arabized Harasi in Oman



Are they Arabs or Bedouins? The Harasis have a Bedouin background but like many other Bedouins, they tend to become more like the dominant Arabic speaking culture around them. Though they have their own Harsusi language, most also speak Arabic, the trade language of Oman.

Ministry Obstacles

The Arabized Harasi people live in Oman, a country that is almost entirely Muslim. They live in a culture where Islam as a religious and political force is seldom challenged. There are almost no Christian believers in that country to explain their reason for faith in the risen Savior.

Outreach Ideas

It's possible that radio broadcasts will be effective with this people group that sometimes lives on the edge of Omani civilization.

Prayer Focus

Pray for faithful intercessors for the Arabized Harasi people until there is a strong movement to Christ among
